Making Connections- Extension

Compare and contrast the "I Have A Dream," speech, The Fight For What's Right," drama, or "The Julian Castro" speech using the Double Bubble Thinking Map to make connections between two texts of YOUR CHOICE! :)

<u>Learning Target</u>: I can analyze how two different authors achieved similar messages and highlight details about their author's craft in a <u>Comparative Analysis</u> literary response.

Consider these text <u>SIMILARITIES</u> and write about them:

- 1. **Theme** Life lesson the author wants the reader to take away
- 2. Setting- Historical and cultural impact on the text (TPE)
- 3. Author's Purpose- P/I/E/E Verb with a Synonym Verb

Consider these text **DIFFERENCES** and write about them:

- 1. Genre <u>and</u> Text Structure
- 2. Point of View: 1st person and/ or 3rd person omniscient
- 3. **GIST** Summarize the "main points" within each text in a BME order using:
 - Main ideas only!
 - Avoid "N" or "B" statements narrow/ broad
