Characterization is when an author shows a character's personality by how the character looks, acts, talks, and interacts with other characters.

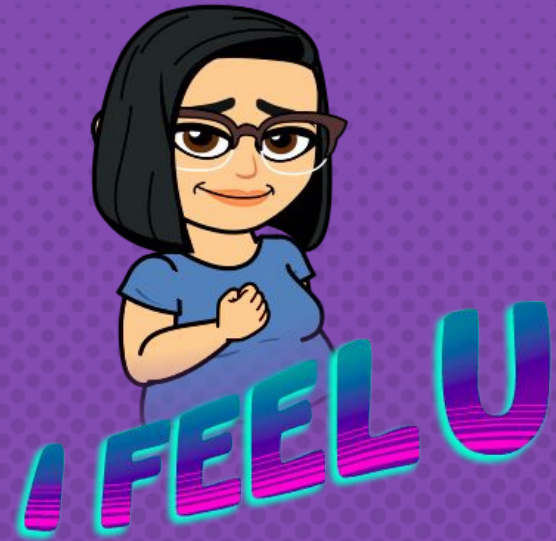
